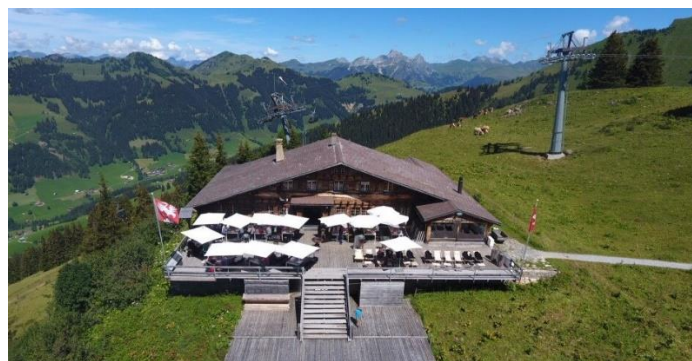

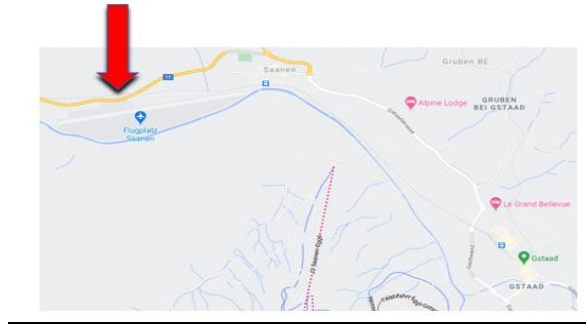

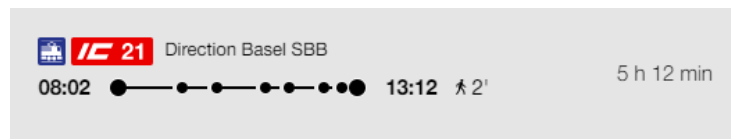

Trainstation Saanen at 7' ( East ), walking to the airport reception

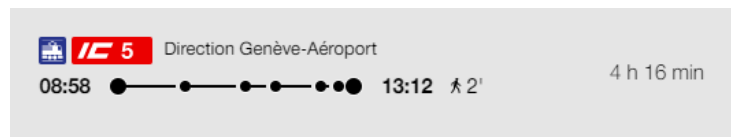
